## FOR TROUTDALE RESIDENTS ONLY

"If I receive *The Champion* in my mailbox, does that mean I can take part in the Spring Cleanup?"

**Not necessarily.** Please check your utility bill – if you do not pay your water bill to the City of Troutdale, you are not eligible to take part in Spring Cleanup events. Still unsure? Contact Troutdale City Hall at 503-665-5175 to confirm your residency.

### MAY 2

#### Additional Garbage Curbside Collection (FREE)

**When:** Wednesday, May 2, by 6 a.m.

**Where:** At your curb

Waste Management will collect up to five (5) additional bags (**total** weight not to exceed 45 pounds) of non-hazardous household garbage (no yard debris) on the regularly scheduled Wednesday curbside pick-up. There is no extra cost for Troutdale residents.

### MAY 5

#### Bulky Waste Curbside Collection (FREE)

**When:** Saturday, May 5, by 6 a.m.

**Where:** At your curb

Waste Management will collect the volume equivalent of one large couch, or up to five (5) bags worth of bulky items, placed curbside for Troutdale residents. Please bag small items. **Volumes greater than one large couch will require a separate pick-up scheduled through Waste Management, and will be billed at the appropriate rate.**

**Accepted:** Bicycles, BBQs, box springs, carpeting, furniture, lawn mowers, mattresses, refrigerators, scrap metal, sinks, tires (five maximum), toilets, water heaters, windows.

**Not Accepted:** Animal waste, batteries, car engines, concrete, dirt, sod or stumps, food waste, hazardous materials (see information at the bottom of this page), liquids, paint, propane tanks, rock, roofing materials.

#### Electronics Recycling Drop-Off (FREE)

**When:** Saturday, May 5 • 9 a.m.-Noon

**Where:** Glenn Otto Park parking lot, 1106 E Historic Columbia River Highway

**Accepted:** AV equipment, cameras, computers, computer peripherals, DVD players, monitors, networking devices, phones, printers, televisions, VCRs and most other small electronics

**Not Accepted:** Batteries, ballasts, fluorescent tubes and lamps, and items containing Freon will **not** be accepted.

#### Paper Shredding Drop-Off (FREE)

**Where:** Troutdale Police Community Center, cul-de-sac at 2nd Street & 234 SW Kendall Court

#### Ongoing Recycling and Disposal Opportunities

##### Prescription Drug Disposal (FREE)

**When:** Year-round, 24/7

**Where:** Troutdale Police Community Center lobby, 234 SW Kendall Court

Citizens can anonymously dispose of unused, expired or unwanted over-the-counter and prescription drugs in an eco-friendly manner year-round by dropping the drugs in the MedReturn box at the Troutdale Community Police Center. Materials **not accepted** include: thermometers, needles, and medical waste. Contact Metro at 503-234-3000 or Waste Management at 1-800-808-5901 about disposal options for infectious waste and sharps containers. **Remember to never flush prescription drugs down the toilet or pour them down the drain!**

##### Hazardous Waste Disposal
