Downtown sidewalk improvements coming in June

Construction of sidewalk improvements to several blocks along the East Historic Columbia River Highway in downtown Troutdale will begin on Monday, June 4 and should be completed by the third week in June. Pedestrian “bulb outs” and ramp improvements will be constructed at several crosswalks to make it easier and safer for pedestrians and people using mobility devices to cross the downtown highway.

The crosswalk improvements at Dora Street and Harlow Avenue will comply with requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act. The improvements will match those being built by a private developer at the Discovery Blocks on the south side of the Historic Highway this year.

Project Update

- **Schedule:** Construction will be completed in June. Work hours will be from 7 am to 8 pm Monday to Friday, except for several early morning concrete pours. No weekend work is planned, to avoid impacting businesses on weekends.
- **Traffic Impacts:**
 - One lane of the Historic Highway, Dora Street or Harlow Ave. may be closed at times during work hours. When a lane is closed, flaggers will direct traffic through the work zone. No detour or road closure will be required.
 - On-street parking next to the crosswalks will be closed during construction hours.
 - Brief pedestrian detours will occur when sidewalk ramps are upgraded. Individual businesses will be notified about work near their entrances.
- **Early Completion Incentive:** There is a financial incentive if contractor Brown Contracting completes the work ahead of schedule. There are financial penalties if the work is completed late.

Multnomah County and the City of Troutdale regret any inconvenience to the public during construction. The improvements will support downtown Troutdale’s accessibility and safety.
